Under the leadership of our vice president and grants committee chair, **Kirra Jarratt**, our Grants Committee enabled us to reach out to a **significantly larger number of organizations** than ever before, nearly doubling the number of grants made in the prior year. And while we continued to make grants to many organizations we have supported in the past, many of our 2011 grants were made to first-time Foundation grantees. We were also able to make a first-time ever "Super Grant" of \$10,000 to the Domestic Violence Legal Empowerment and Appeals Project, DV LEAP.

Because of the great work of our grants committee and the entire board, I am proud to say that our grants continue to be a solid reflection on both the Foundation and on the WBA.

While there is much good news to report, there is still much to accomplish and that is why we are in the midst of a long range planning process. The next major step in that process is a twoday meeting in August to plan the future of the Foundation and its impact on our community. To help us in this process, we are conducting an electronic survey of all WBA members and other stakeholders to better understand what you see as the needs in our community which the foundation should be addressing. The survey will include a range of questions about personal and professional interests and our grant making. When you receive an invitation to participate in the survey, please make the time to complete it. Your responses matter and will be invaluable in our planning for next year and beyond.

Finally, I want to remind you about our "<u>Uniting for Justice</u>" campaign. If you have attended any Foundation events over the past year, you will have heard about this fundraising and outreach campaign designed to strengthen our grant making capabilities and broaden our reach in the community.
